# Presbyterian Women Presbytery of Western North Carolina Scholarship Information

The Scholarship Committee of Presbyterian Women of the Presbytery of Western North Carolina wishes to make the following information known to all local Presbyterian women groups and scholarship applicants.

A Scholarship Committee of Presbyterian Women of the Presbytery administers the scholarship program. The committee is chaired by the Scholarship Facilitator of the PW and at least two appointed members. The Treasurer of the PW of the Presbytery shall be ex-officio member of the Scholarship Committee.

- 1. Scholarship value \$3000.00 for an academic year, payable to the educational institution where the applicant has been accepted and/or is enrolled, payable in two increments of \$1500.00 each.
- 2. One new applicant will be selected each year and must:
  - be members of a Presbyterian Church of the Presbytery of Western North Carolina
  - be of sound Christian character
  - show proof of validated scholastic ability
  - demonstrate need of financial assistance to further their education
  - be graduates of an accredited high school or preparatory school
  - have qualified for admission to an accredited institution of higher learning or are presently enrolled in four-year program of undergraduate study at such an institution
- 3. How to Apply? Each local Moderator of Presbyterian Women will receive scholarship application forms. She shall make available these forms or web site address, https://presbyterywnc.org, to interested members in her church. Copies may be made as needed. Each form must be filled out completely before being considered by the Scholarship Committee.
- 4. Scholarship Renewal If satisfactory GPA is maintained, the recipient is eligible for scholarship renewal of one year. Applications of renewal must be made by letter or by email request along with grades for the first semester by the 15<sup>th</sup> of June.
- 5. Time for Application The application form, school transcript(s), and letters of recommendation must be postmarked by February 15<sup>th</sup> to be considered for scholarship for the following school year.
- 6. What Educational Institutions are valid? Accredited colleges and universities. Applicants must be enrolled in a four-year degree program. Technical or graduate schools are excluded from consideration.
- 7. Criteria for Awarding Scholarships Financial need, scholas capability, leadership of applicant in church, school and community, and references.
