

PWNC GUATEMALA SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

“STEPS IN FORMING A SCHOLARSHIP PARTNERSHIP”

1. Guatemalan church expresses scholarship need.
2. PWNC church agrees to accept the educational need and to develop a partnership.
3. Guatemala Partnership Committee provides model covenants to the Guatemalan church.
4. PWNC Guatemala Scholarship Committee (PWNC-GSC) provides model covenants to the WNC church.
5. Together the partner churches of WNC and Guatemala develop the scope of the program.
6. Establish Covenants for:
 - a. PWNC Church and sponsor (if using)
 - b. PWNC Church and pen pals (if using)
 - c. PWNC church and Guatemala church
 - d. Guatemala church and parent
 - e. Guatemala church and student
7. Each church presents their proposal to its respective Presbytery for approval.
8. PWNC-GSC reviews the program(s) looking for disparities and a need to add other churches to the partnership program(s)
9. PWNC-GSC publishes needs and seeks the support of other churches.
10. PWNC-GSC pairs churches with those needing additional support
11. Money being sent to covenant churches for scholarships should be in the PWNC office no later than November 1st to be sent with the teams making November visits,
12. Money for funding the Scholarship program should be sent as well (this includes money for their committee meetings, parent support meetings and the 5% of the total amount for the Guatemalan Presbytery (Suchitepéquez or Sur Occidente) and 5% for the national denomination in Guatemala
