Report of the Steering Team for Iglesia Emanuel, Hickory ~ May 25, 2010

We had our Steering Team/Administrative Commission meeting on Sunday, May 13, 2010 in the Conference Room of the church. All members attended except Joe Carroll from Northminster, who had said he was not available on this date. Carlos Henry, president of the Directiva, joined us.

Jorge Alvarado, the organizing Pastor, has had some serious health concerns, and had an artery opened up in a procedure. He is now feeling much better.

The Pastor reported that some former members have returned and some new families are visiting the church. They have started a women's ministry and also hope to get a Men's Fellowship going. They have a teacher for children and are hoping to get a teacher for teenagers. They also have three members attending the Lay Pastor training in Greensboro; two teens to Triennium, and also two children to Camp Grier.

The Steering Team affirmed the mission and vision developed by the Directiva:

MISSION

We are a church of diverse cultures who gather for praising God and serving in the community.

VISION

Our vision is to be a family united by God's love to share our faith in Jesus throughout Catawba County.

Their objectives are:

- To have an effective Christian Education program for children and youth;
- To maintain the unity within the fellowship;
- To grow by 10% in 2010;
- To make their sanctuary and education space more welcoming;
- To celebrate birthdays and anniversaries each month.

They are also actively questioning if their worship at 12:30 on Sundays is the best time for their congregation and community.

The Steering Team read the booklet from GA, *Living the Vision: Hispanic Ministries*. The issues that were raised from this reading was the question of what language or languages are needed in the ministry. Also, the reality that many Hispanic ministries are not self-supporting in ten years.

The financial report from the local congregation showed a slight deficit at the end of April (-161.10). However part of this was the purchase of a new computer, and also there were high utility bills. They are contributing \$100/month towards the insurance on the building held by Presbytery.

The Steering Team affirmed that the Standards and Guidelines from Salem Presbytery for Jorge's ministry are also maintained in PWNC.

Our next meeting will be a joint meeting with the Steering Team of Rowan County Hispanic Ministries. We are coordinating with them before we set a date.

NEW VISION, CONOVER NEW CHURCH DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATIVE COMMISSION REPORT

July 27, 2010

From **NEW VISION CHURCH** in Conover ~ May 25, 2010

Easter was the one year anniversary of launch of New Vision Church. We celebrated with four baptisms (two teens, a child and an infant) and three new covenant members (who are Hispanic). We sing praise music that had been written by three of our band members, none of whom were a part of this congregation a year ago. We have a KIDS Club and children's church and a TEENs group. We have a committed and creative leadership core.

We continue to grow, however not at the rate we would like to see. We do outreach events, such as a booth at the Spring Fling at our partner elementary school where we did face painting and visors as well as invitations to VBS, which is our next major outreach event. We send out cards to new residents. And the leadership has recognized the need for prayer, and gathers after worship every Sunday around the table for intensive prayer for our ministry.

We find that we do have a very positive reputation in the community, especially because of the Pack-a-Bag program at our partner elementary school. We are feeding eighty kids every weekend, with seven meals that they can make. We have developed community support that helps pay for this ministry.

Our concerns are finances. We did not get the Walton grant that we hoped would give us some breathing space while we grew. We have met with Bobbi White and Anita Bernhardt to discuss our options and are pursuing them now: re-finance the mortgage for a longer time and better rate; apply for Synod grants for small churches and multi-ethnic ministries; and to raise some support from local congregations.

With the retirement of our Steering Team Chair, Jerry Bron, in January 2011, we need to add some members to the Steering Team. We would hope that these could be from neighboring congregations and those who might be able to offer support, especially First, Hickory (suggest asking Greg Smith) and First, Newton (suggest asking Mark Watson or Beth Hill).
